JOB SUMMARY

Under the supervision of the Program Manager and the Store Manager, the successful applicant will be responsible for acting as a host to visitors, providing information and detailed site tours to groups of various ages, and assisting in the planning and execution of special events. This position also requires a willingness to demonstrate old-fashioned activities and the ability to assist in site maintenance.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Greet and welcome all visitors to the site.
- Conduct guided tours of the buildings and grounds of Huble Homestead to regular visitors, school programs, and tour groups.
- Assist in the development and execution of special events and site rentals.
- Lead games and activities for visitors of various ages, and help present demonstrations of old-fashioned activities such as making butter, preparing ice cream, etc.
- Perform food related duties, such as food preparation, cooking, serving, and cleaning.
- Assist with the day-to-day operations of the General Store, which include customer sales, product restocking, inventory, store accounting, cash handling, and manual credit card transactions.
- Assist with general site maintenance and garden upkeep.
- All other duties as required.
